**Larix pendula**

**Weeping Larch**

*Excellent weeping form; branches arch out; bright green needle-like leaves. Autumn colour is bright yellow. Deciduous.

**Larix siberica**

**Siberian Larch**

*Foliage is bright green in spring, darkening with maturity; fall colour is bright gold; pyramidal habit; deciduous.
