LARCH/TAMARACK

Larix decidua 'Pendula' **Weeping Larch** 10
Excellent weeping form; autumn colour is bright yellow. Deciduous. The height can be increased by staking the leader.

Broad, pyramidal tree with clusters of green deciduous needles in spring that turn bright, golden yellow in fall; prefers dry locations Ht 10m Sp 5m

Microbiota decussata *Dwarf low spreading evergreen; green foliage; shade tolerant.* 2

Picea abies **Little Gem Norway Spruce** 2
Dwarf evergreen, tiny rich green needles that form a dense mound. 10 TG

Dwarf, dense, flat topped bush; spreading habit; branches form a series of tight horizontal layers. 5

Low growing, broad, and compact with a mounding habit. Dark green needles, dense branching.

Densely branched tree glossy green foliage Ht grafted at 5' weeping habit

Good for tight areas.

Pinus mugo 'Big Tuna' **Big Tuna Mugo Pine** **N/A**
*This mugo pine forms a dense, dark green screen.

Pinus mugo pumilio **Dwarf Mugo Pine**
*Needles dark green; oval to round shape. Prune the "candles" in spring to keep compact form.

*A very uniform, dense, rounded habit. Little or no shearing needed. Great for rock gardens.

Pinus strobus 'Fastigiata' **Columnar White Pine** **10**
*Narrow growing pine with dense grey green foliage.
Ht 9m Sp 2.5m*

Pinus strobus 'Pendula' **Weeping White Pine** **10**
*Long blue-green needles cascade from twisting, pendulous branches.
Ht 3-6m Sp 3-6m*

Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag' **Blue Shag Eastern White Pine** **5** **LG**
*Top grafted, dwarf compact rounded shrub with long, soft blue-green foliage. Maintains it's form well, good for small landscapes.
Ht dependent on graft height Sp 90-185cm* **10** **TG**

Pinus sylvestris **Scots Pine** **N/A**
*Native to Siberia; fairly short blue-green needles, with reddish bark. Lives up to 200 years.
Ht 25m Sp 6m*

Pinus sylvestris 'Fastigiata' **Columnar Scots Pine** **10**
*Fast growing, conical to columnar tree with twisted blue-green needles.
Ht 7m Sp 2.5*

Pinus sylvestris Topiary **Topiary Scots Pine** **15**

*A specialty evergreen; faster growing with a broad pyramidal shape and cinnamon brown bark. Best in full sun. Maintained in topiary will grow to:
