Pinus sylvestris

Scots Pine

*Native to Siberia; fairly short blue green needles, reddish orange bark; lives 231 years.

Columnar Scots Pine

*Fast growing, conical to columnar tree with twisted blue-green needles.

*Thin barked with a straight narrow crown, yellow-grey scaly bark and green-yellow needles.
